SCHEDULING POLICY

Please bring your insurance card to each visit, and also be prepared to pay your co-pay if applicable. We ask that you <u>arrive 15 minutes prior to your appointment time</u> to update and verify your child's personal information. Because we respect every patient's time, <u>if you are 10min late</u> for your child's appointment, you will be <u>asked to reschedule</u>, so that the following patients that day can be seen on time. You will also be charged a fee (see below).

CANCELLATION POLICY

We have a <u>48hr cancellation policy</u> for all appointments and testing. We understand that circumstances sometimes require you to miss an appointment. Failure to notify us when you find it necessary to cancel or reschedule however, could result in our request that you find another practice more convenient for your needs. You will also be charge a fee (see below).

FEES

Late/Missed Appointment: \$50 Late/Missed Stimulation Testing: \$100
